Brief instructions before outpatient treatment under general anaesthesia

A specialist has recommended that your child undergo outpatient dental treatment under general anaesthesia. This means that you will have to come to our clinic for treatment on the day of the procedure and return home with the child the same day. You will accompany your child for the treatment and also participate in supervision during the recovery after treatment. Please, come to our outpatient clinic at the scheduled hour, accompanied by at least one Czech-speaking person. Please, arrange for transportation by car in the presence of two adults at the anticipated time of the end of the procedure.

Things to bring with you:

- **Insurance card.**
- **Pre-operative examination report not older than 14 days** (paediatric examination with a conclusion confirming the ability to undergo the procedure under general anaesthesia, with a detailed history focusing on the perinatal period, neurological diseases, outpatient care, allergies, chronic medication). If it is necessary to prevent infectious endocarditis, your paediatrician will provide the necessary antibiotics. The paediatrician will also indicate any necessary laboratory tests. It is necessary to inform us about the weight of the child before the procedure.
- **Coagulation Disorder Questionnaire.**
- **Consent to Treatment under General Anaesthesia Form.**
- **We recommend that you bring one spare cotton T-shirt and sweatpants** (wet cooling of the drill).

In the evening before the procedure, serve the child only easily digestible food (such as mashed potatoes, pastries, breakfast, biscuits), **no later than 6 hours before the scheduled procedure.**

The child is allowed to have a last drink 4 hours before the procedure. Tea or water with syrup are the most suitable options while juice, milk and carbonated drinks (with CO₂ bubbles) are not suitable.

!!! In case of non-compliance, this is an absolute contraindication to the procedure!!!

Make sure that the child drinks a lot but eats only small amounts of easily digestible food during the **12 hours** after the procedure.

Only give the child the medicines recommended by the treating physician. The child should not be left unattended for **24 hours** after the procedure.

Any activity requiring increased concentration must be ruled out during the **36 hours** after the procedure.

The child may complain of pain in the neck, muscles, or surgical wound for **a few days** after the procedure. The child may also be moody. In case of any health problem, contact your treating physician.

Please, call 734 255 676 from 7:30 a.m. to noon the day before the scheduled date. You will be told at which hour you should come for the procedure.

If the child becomes ill, you must bring a certificate from your paediatrician and you will be offered a new date.

If you do not come without a proper and timely excuse (no later than 24 hours before the day of the procedure), the paid deposit will be used to cover the related costs. In case of non-compliance with the above instructions, especially the period of fasting, the booking will be cancelled and the deposit will be retained.

I hereby confirm that I consent to the date: _____ of the procedure under general anaesthesia and that I will comply with the conditions set out in the Brief Instructions document, which was handed over to me today. I consent to pay for the professional assistance of another physician, which is not reimbursed by the health insurance company. Reimbursement is based on a minute-by-minute calculation prepared by the physicians, and I was informed about the estimated duration of the procedure.
